The following items were received from Mr S. Smith and Mr J.R. Wingfield.

Introduction

This Club was opened in 1912, and apart from bowls and tennis, also has a badminton section. It is sited at the top of Bellingham Road. Mr H.H. Shattock was elected as the first President. It was the first London Club to have two Cumberland turf greens. The Clubhouse was burnt down in 1913, and bombs in the Second World War hit the grounds. Throughout the years, additions were made to the Club premises. In 1977, the Club purchased the freehold of the site. The administration of the Club is handled by the Executive Committee, among which are the President, Honorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer, and the Sectional Committees for the different kinds of sport pursued, and for other activities undertaken. Temporary Committees were formed to handle the events and activities occasioned by anniversaries of the Club's foundation, in 1962 and 1987. It may be remembered that in 1962, to mark the Club's golden Jubilee, an exhibition of selected archives was exhibited in the Manor House Library.

Catford Cycling Club

Introduction

The Catford Cycling Club was founded in 1886, originating from an idea by Charles Percival Sisley, during the period when there was an enthusiasm for cycling nationally. It is still flourishing to this day. From the outset, the Club set its sights high, its motto being National-not local. Indeed, by 1890, the Club Prospectus stated that the Club is nothing less than a national institution. Membership was drawn from many parts of the country, and overseas, though most came from South London. The stated aims of the Club were to promote Sport, Road Riding, Racing, Touring, Good fellowship. It was the first Club to introduce road handicaps open to all amateurs, and international team racing. It was a very active Club, with a wide programme of sporting and social events, the latter being predominant in the winter months. The Club was managed by an elected Executive, which had specific officers to handle each type of cycling event. Initially only men were allowed to become full members, until 1972, though there was a Ladies' Section, who attended social events from the outset. The Old Kittens came into existence as a dinner club for senior members in 1926. There are two published histories of the Club, The first fifty years and the second fifty years, written by E.J. Southcott and R.A. Reynolds respectively, both of which are available in the Local History and Archives Centre.

Introduction

The school grew out of a charitable bequest by Robert Aske, a wealthy member of the Haberdashers' Company. This bequest initially founded a hospital and school in Hoxton in 1692, the latter for sons of Haberdashers. In 1873 the charity was reorganised, following the demolition of the original hospital and school buildings. Haberdasher Aske's School was opened, as a grammar school, on, Jerningham Road, New Cross, in 1875, originally as two schools, one for boys and one for girls. In 1946, they became voluntarily controlled: maintained by the LEA, but retaining close links with the Haberdashers' Company, who retained their seats on the Board of Governors. From 1965, there was close collaboration between the Boys' and Girls' schools. In 1979, the schools went fully comprehensive. They formally merged when their status changed once again, to become a City Technology College (CTC), in 1991. The content of this archive relates to the Boy's school, unless otherwise indicated.

He was opposition spokesman on higher education and science 1972-1974, then Parliamentary Secretary to M.A.F.F. 1974; Minister of State for Northern Ireland 1974-76 and for the Health Service 1976-79. He was the opposition spokesman on health 1979-80, deputy foreign affairs spokesman 1980-83, and spokesman on defence and disarmament 1983. He was made a Privy Councillor in 1978.

Lewisham Local History Society was founded in 1961 on the initiative of the then Borough Librarian, Roy Rates. Since 1965 it has also covered the former Metropolitan Borough of Deptford. In the late 1960s the Society began collecting museum objects, with the intention that they should form a basic collection for a future Borough Museum. Since 1971 the museum collection has been stored in Lewisham Libraries premises - originally in the flat above New Cross Library, which was shared with Lewisham Natural History Society. The Society has published various pamphlets and booklets on local history since 1975, and annual Transactions from 1963 to 1988; the Lewisham History Journal from 1993 replaced the Transactions. All the Society's publications are in the book collection at the Local History Centre.

Introduction

This collection includes deeds, correspondence, financial material, photographs and miscellaneous items

Walter Cobb Ltd, began as a ladies' outfitters at Kirkdale, Sydenham, in 1861, being described as a General Drapery Establishment in 1862, which sold dresses, shawls and mantles, millinery and family mourning. Cobb's advertisement claimed he stocked all the latest fashions from London and Paris. The business premises expanded, occupying 18-24 Kirkdale in 1894, 5-9, 14-22 Kirkdale in 1921. By this time the company had branched out as an undertakers and also sold furniture, having a furniture depository at Silverdale. It also provided restaurant facilities. It was incorporated as a private company in 1912. It was bombed during World War II and rebuilding was not finally completed until 1960. In these post war years, the firm diversified and sold menswear and hardware as well as their established products. The firm closed in 1981. This archive has much relating to the expansion of Cobbs and the post war reconstruction.

Introduction

This collection contains Leases, mortgages of leaseholds, assignments of leaseholds, agreements for tenancies & related papers re property in Harefield Road, Harefield Terrace & Brockley Road, Deptford, which are the property records of Cave Austen & Co. 16 Harefield Terrace was at the corner with Brockley Road, and became known as 199 Brockley Road in the 1870s. The extension, built shortly afterwards, was numbered 199a and in 1878 was a butcher's shop. 199 was originally owned by the Kersey family [Robert and William] and in 1873 it was sold to Sadler William Tebbs [c. 1828 - 1892], who sold the property to Henry Mandle in 1880. Henry died before 1910 and Cave Austen & Co Ltd purchase the freehold on the property in the 1920s. J & A Austen first leased the property in 1896 and transferred the lease on becoming a limited company to Cave Austen & Co Ltd in 1897, they were wine merchants by 2007 199 was Mira Off-licence [postcode SE4 2RS].

In 2002 there was a planning application to build on the yard behind the shop. It cited "The yard and garage at the rear of No199 is now in separate ownership from the shop and are currently vacant. The rear yard between No. 199 Brockley Road and the application site has been developed with single storey lock-up shops facing Harefield Road. The site is located within the Brockley Conservation Area, which was designated in 1976. Site history was in 1963, planning permission was granted for the erection of five lock-up shops at the rear of the property, fronting Harefield Road. Among the various applications submitted in respect of these units, the following are worthy of note. In 1992, planning permission was refused for the change of use of Nos. 1A and 1B to a restaurant/cafe (Use Class A3) on the grounds that it was likely to generate excessive traffic movements and on-street parking close to a busy road junction. A similar planning application was refused the same year for the use of Nos. 1 and 1A Harefield Road as a take-away hot food shop(Use Class A3). The reason for refusal also being because of traffic considerations. However, in 1996 the decision was taken to grant planning permission for a take-away hot food shop at No. 1 Harefield Road, the smaller scale nature of the proposed use not being considered so likely to give rise to traffic problems. In 1993, the use of the land and garage at the rear of No 199 for the storage of motor vehicles was granted planning permission for a limited period, subject to no trade or business being carried out from the premises.

In 1994, an Enforcement Notice requiring the cessation of the use of this site and garage for vehicle repairs was served and appears to have been complied with. In January 1999, planning permission was granted for the redevelopment of the yard and garage at the rear of No. 199 to provide a single storey storage unit, with customer entrance onto Harefield Road. During the consideration of this application, the applicant was advised by officers not to include any two-storey provision within the proposal and to keep the height of the proposed building as



low as possible. This scheme was never implemented. 2007 a planning application for the redevelopment of the rear of No. 199B rockley Road to provide a terrace of 3, one-bedroom town houses and a restaurant was withdrawn. It was considered that the reuse of the existing lock up shop unit for A3 purposes was acceptable but that the proposed residential units were poorly designed and out of keeping with the character of the Conservation Area.
